- Shaw & Smith Sauv Blanc, SA** 60
The current offering is bright and aromatic with notes of grapefruit, nashi pear and nettles. On the palate there is intense flavour with fresh, limey fruit, mouth-watering acidity and remarkable purity.
- Coldstream Guard Sauvignon Blanc Levantine Hill, VIC** 48
This snappy Sauvignon Blanc is a real treat and among the Yarra's best examples of the variety. Showing ripe tropical fruit, passionfruit and gooseberry with grassy undertones it is fresh crisp and dry
- Lawsons Dry Hills Sauvignon Blanc, NZ** 38
A refreshing Sauvignon Blanc with richness of passionfruit, herb and mineral flavours. The nose is soft and elegantly proportioned with aromas of passionfruit, white floral aromas and nuances of fresh herbs and mineral notes. Lively on the palate and wonderfully structured by juicy acidity.
- Craggy Range Sauv Blanc, NZ** 60
This is a wine with quite brilliant structure consisting of a fine line of acid and great minerality. Flavour notes of herbs, wet slate and gooseberry to give some varietal lift.
- Levantine Hill Sauv & Semillon, VIC** 45
Overall complexity is enhanced by barrel fermentation on varying levels of grape solids. The palate is silken and long, with a fine interwoven backbone of natural acidity providing the framework for persistent tangy stone fruit flavours and a supple textural finish.
- Pierro LTC Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, WA** 60
A clean and concentrated palate of lemon sherbet and gooseberry with a hint of oak influence. Its fullness and texture is experienced with the whole mouth and tied together with a zippy acidity.
- Coldstream Guard Chardonnay, VIC** 48
Pale straw in colour, this has a complex nose comprising white nectarine, a touch of chamomile, subtle florals and a fleeting buttery note.
- Craggy Range Chardonnay, NZ** 70
A full bodied Chardonnay with refreshing elements that arise from a lovely acid backbone. The flavours are voluptuous, tropical fruit-filled and polished. The new oak is well integrated into the wine and the finish is moderately long.
- Levantine Chardonnay, VIC** 110
Complex fruit characters of white nectarine, saffron, Pink Lady apple, chamomile flower, cashews and Leatherwood honey work in concert with a tactile interplay of chalk, silkiness and Beurre Bosc pear-like texture. Subtle acidity provides the backbone conveying the fruit and weight to a resounding finish.

Katherine's Paddock Chardonnay, VIC **185**

Expressing elegance, sophistication and textural complexity, its exceptional fruit has been carefully picked and sorted before being fermented and matured in fine French oak. A complex, medium bodied Chardonnay with notes of stonefruit and grilled nuts

Hogsbreath Chardonnay, SA **40**

This wooded Chardonnay has aromas of intense grapefruit and white peach with a mealy (lees worked) complexity. The palate experiences a concentration of citrus and stone fruit with cashew nuts and a creamy texture. The wine is effortlessly mouth filling with a delicate balance of fruit and acidity and a long lingering finish.

Burns & Fuller Chardonnay, SA **38**

Unmistakably cool-climate Chardonnay characters of stone fruit, zesty Granny Smith apple flavour and soft subtle oak are all on offer here.

The Dry Dam D'Arenberg Riesling, SA **44**

This Riesling shows divine varietal character underlined by a citrus punch that engages on the back of powerful floral aroma. Pithy lime flavours flow through to a slightly textured finish.

International White

Pasqua Delle Venezie Pinot Grigio, Italy **38**

Pale and delicate in colour with subtle citrus and floral aromas. The palate is elegant and delightfully fresh with delicate citrus and tropical flavours building to notes of ripe pear matched by soft mineral acidity before a dry finish.

Moscato Sweet, Italy **35**

Floral aroma. Honeysuckle, jasmine, green apple...and then chalky mineral. Incredibly layered and complex. The palate is more stereotypically Moscato. Caramel apple and cotton candy with the barest hint of that mineral character from the aroma.

Domaine Oudin Chablis **110**

Pale yellow in the glass with shimmering silver highlights. The nose is bright with citrus, brine and flakey limestone notes. The palate shows elegant citrus fruit backed by lovely limestone driven minerality. This is a crisp, elegant wine that is never austere.

Petit Chablis Laroche, France
125

A generous and elegant wine. Light golden colour. Intense nose of flower, brioche and candied lemon aromas, evolving towards nuances of grilled hazelnut and spice as the wine matures. On the palate, the wine is straightforward, with a nice texture and finesse. It has a long aftertaste where floral and gingerbread notes dominate.

Jouis Jadot Chablis Montee De Tonnerre, France **185**

Offers aromas of lemon oil, oyster shell, gun-flint and complex floral notes with a well-integrated oak character. Well-balanced ripeness/acidity on the palate, with a long, lingering finish.

Sancerre A.O.C., France 85

Intense and complex, this fresh, mineral wine with hints of grapefruit. The Sancerre Blanc vines are planted in communes within the Sancerre appellation. Grapes are harvested terroir by terroir when they reach their peak of ripeness. The juices from each individual terroir are then blended harmoniously to yield a unique and versatile wine.

Chateau de Sancerre, France 110

A delightful pale golden hue with highlights of silver, intense aromas of boxwood and grapefruit are carried through to flavours enhanced by the addition of white floral notes.

Chateau Cotes De Provence Rose, France 60

This light bodied rose is bright with vibrant strawberries, raspberries, rosewater and watermelon tones and set the scene for a bone dry, refreshingly crisp and deliciously supple palate with a dry savoury finish.

DC Le Grand Cros Cotes De Provence Rose, France 50

Very pale salmon pink. The nose is dominated by wild berries with fresh strawberry, cherry, grapefruit along with some mineral notes. The mouth is both soft and fresh with a nice fruity presence including cherries and red currant.

Levantine Hill Rose, VIC 45

A complex Rosé of serious character and intensity, beginning with aromas of strawberry, cranberry and quince. Layered on these primary characters are subtle lifted notes of Turkish delight and watermelon. Savoury aromatics of musk stick and caraway are underpinned by enticing summer fruits and further entice the senses.

Red Wine

Levantine Hill Cabernet Sauvignon, VIC 110

Signature varietal aromas of cassis, blackberry, aniseed, dark chocolate and cedar are supported by less common notes of saffron, pistachio nut and Vietnamese mint.

Don Camillo Cabernet Sauvignon/Sangiovese, Italy 50

This full bodied single vineyard Cabernet sauvignon from their Angaston vineyard is all about ripe juicy fruit, hint of mint and tobacco. Barossa Cabernet is often under appreciated but good spice, depth and structure here.

Maitre 'D' Cabernet Sauvignon by MollyDooker, SA 70

This bright and lively wine is awash with notes of cherry, strawberry and blackcurrant. The rich fruit flavours, coupled with the soft tannins adds to the wine's complexity. A lingering aftertaste of intense fresh plum and spice finishes this wine off beautifully.

‘Two Left Feet’ Shiraz Merlot Cabernet by MollyDooker, SA 70

Fruits of dark cherry, blackberry, plum and raspberry are complimented by the secondary notes of vanilla and mixed spices. The silky, satin like fruit profile, encompassed by lovely ripe tannins, cascades effortlessly through the.

Round Two Merlot, SA 38

This full bodied wine blends plum and chocolate with cigar box characters in a complex but smooth blend. A full-bodied, voluptuous wine with fine tannins and ripe, berry fruit flavours balanced by earthiness and spice. Subtle oak characters give complexity and enhance the rich, yet smooth and typically merlot palate.

Levantine Hill Syrah, VIC 70

The elegant medium-bodied palate with spice and earthy nuances in a concentration of savouriness. The silky ripe tannins have been deftly integrated with the underlying oak providing carriage for the fruit weight and lingering flavours to a pronounced finish.

Melissa’s Paddock Syrah, VIC 225

Medium dusty ruby color. Spicy aromas and flavours of fresh cracked pepper, cedar and sandalwood, spiced dark berries and beets, and parmesan herb bread with a satiny, vibrant, fruity full body and a warming, distinctive, long chocolate drizzled pomegranates, fruit leather, and toffeed nuts finish with chewy, crunchy tannins and light oak. A spicy, mouthwatering syrah with deeply delightful flavors and pure varietal character.

Inigo Shiraz, SA 55

Old vine fruit delivers intense aromas of black olives and cherries to the Inigo shiraz. This outplant, black fruit continues on the imposing palates finishing with lone-fine tannins

The Coldstream Guard Shiraz, VIC 65

Palate has a thick core of briary, tarry, dark berry fruit with some licorice and chocolate. The wine displays good length with some lovely chewy tannin and a nice bit of quality sweet oak on the finish.

Blue Eyed Boy Shiraz by MollyDooker, SA 90

Dense black crimson colour and leaps from the glass with powerful aromatics of blueberries, ripe sweet fruit, licorice & undertones of chocolate biscuit. The seductive texture is laced with fresh fruit flavours, coffee & warm spice, a full-bodied Shiraz with an endless depth of fruit.

Gnarly Dudes by Two Hands Shiraz, SA 60

Hits the palate with vibrancy and pop. Bright berry notes dance across the palate. Medium to full bodied with richness of fruit balanced by bright refreshing acidity. Tannins are prominent but melt beautifully into a wall of fruit. Finished with a lovely long palate, accented by notes of red licorice, lavender, and dark chocolate with a creamy texture from lees contact.

Max’s Garden by Two Hands Heathcote Shiraz, VIC 110

Max’s Garden exhibits a rich, earthy texture with lifted spice and a well delineated fruit profile. This is a wine with a soft elegant framework that complements the Garden Series for its distinctiveness. The orange Cambrian soils on which the vineyard is based, thought to be some of the oldest soils in the world, are the inspiration for this label’s colour.

Ben Potts Fiddles Block Shiraz, Langhorne Creek, SA 75

Very deep brick red colour with deep brick red hue. Perfumed nose of violet and spice, followed by a touch of earth and new leather. The palate delivers flavours of plum and liquorice followed by a touch of confectionary and violet infusion. Fine grained slightly chalky tannins. Aftertaste of spice.

Buckshot Heathcote Shiraz, VIC 65

Richness and intensity are the defining characters of this traditional Beast aromatic, where dark fruits, Christmas pudding and liquorice stick fill the nose. Flavours mirror the aromatic profile, balanced here by the combination of grippy tannin throughout and freshness of acidity.

Mollydooker Velvet Glove Shiraz, SA 275

Dark, rich and bold, with a velvety richness to the dense tannins, providing the backbone for thick flavours of black walnut liqueur, blueberry syrup, sandalwood and espresso. Gains intensity on the long finish.

Hentley Farm 'The Beauty' 2016 Shiraz, SA 110

Peach, apricot and florals provide the lift while surrounded by blue and red fruits, white pepper and peaty earth sitting further in the background. This complex combination of flavours continues onto the palate with the blue/red fruits playing the leading role.

Hentley Farm 'The Beast' 2015 Shiraz, SA 165

Richness and intensity are the defining characters of this traditional Beast aromatic, where dark fruits, Christmas pudding and liquorice stick fill the nose. Flavours mirror the aromatic profile, balanced here by the combination of grippy tannin throughout and freshness of acidity.

Hentley Farm Clos Otto Shiraz 2015, SA 250

Traditional dark fruits combine with a complex herbal element with notes of mint and jasmine. Violets are also evident lifting the overall aromatic intensity, highlighting secondary characters such as cigar box, choc mint, leather, graphite and a faint red candy lift.

Hentley Farm Villian & Vixen Shiraz 2017, SA 60

A rich nose with blackcurrant and mulberries leading the way, secondary aromatics of nutmeg, coco and sage provide the alluring complexity. The palate combines rich Barossa fruit with a soft and approachable texture, look for plum, mulberries, raspberries and an array of spices.

'Two Left Feet' Shiraz Merlot Cabernet by MollyDooker, SA 70

Fruits of dark cherry, blackberry, plum and raspberry are complimented by the secondary notes of vanilla and mixed spices. The silky, satin like fruit profile, encompassed by lovely ripe tannins, cascades effortlessly through the.

Teusner Joshua Grenache Shiraz Mataro, SA 65

A blend of 60% old vine Grenache, along with 35% Mataro and 5% Shiraz. The nose offers ripe and fresh aromas of red and dark berry fruit, a touch of cured meat and some lifted spice. Entirely un-oaked, this is savoury and gamey through the palate.

Samantha's Paddock Levantine Hill, VIC 295

Cabernet Sauvignon 81%, Merlot 16%, Cabernet Franc 2%, Petit Verdot 1%. 18 months in Seguin Moreau Icône and Taransaud barrels. Fruit was hand-picked then crushed to open fermenters and inoculated with R15 yeast. Ferments hand-plunged and pumped

over for gentle extraction of colour and tannin.

- The Coldstream Guard Pinot Noir, VIC** 65
This pinot noir has dark cherry flavours, floral and dark fruit aromas, which follow through to the palate where the dark berry-fruit and cherry notes are supported by soft tannins.
- Levantine Hill Pinot Noir, VIC** 135
Leading aromas of black cherries, rhubarb, sage, wet earth, nutmeg and black chocolate with integrated cinnamon oak and a subtle stemmy note contributed by fermentation with stalks. The composed, elegant palate exhibits red fruit flavours of strawberry and cranberry carried by ingrained natural acidity, subtly spreading fruit weight, a line of integrated oak and sweeping low-resolution tannins.
- Colleens Paddock Pinot Noir Levantine Hill, VIC** 195
Savoury herbs, forest floor/composty aromas and sourish dark cherry. The savoury fruit is the hero here as it wades effortlessly about. A lick of something akin to Jersey caramel lobs up late. Super fine and silky smooth, the finish lingers for what seems an eternity.
- Craggy Range Pinot Noir, NZ** 125
Bright red cherry colour with a crimson hue. Seductive aromas of dark cherry, dried rose petals, thyme and damp earth. Beautifully varietal, elegant and long on the palate
- Red Claw Pinot Noir, Mornington Peninsula, VIC** 60
Rich, fragrant aromas are dominated by cherry and dark berry fruits complemented by a touch of spice and underlying French oak. The long, silky palate has a lovely soft and velvety texture, with powerful flavours of dark fruits and a finely poised finish.
- Lawsons Dry Hills Pinot Noir, NZ** 65
Small batch fermentation, hand-plunging and aging in French oak has helped to produce an expressive wine with intense berry fruit, lovely texture, great concentration and gentle tannins.
- Bertaine Pinot Noir, France** 45
Floral and dark fruit aroma with dark cherry flavours, rich mouth feel and savoury toastiness. This has vital cut and thrust to its array of snow pea, gooseberry and guava flavours, the package neatly tied by no-nonsense acidity.
- 10 Minute by Tractor, VIC** 60
Hints of black pepper and blackberry hinting at the balance lying below, the tannins not aggressive, but a presence. The very model of a modern Mornington Pinot.
- Casale Vecchio Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Italy** 55
Bright ruby-red in colour, with delicious aromas of black cherries, strawberries, and herbs, Stella Montepulciano d'Abruzzo is dry, mellow, and concentrated. It is best enjoyed young, in order to fully appreciate its fruity varietal character.
- Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy** 70
Ruby-red. Bouquet: Intense with notes of cherries, plums, and violets. Taste: Rich flavours of cherry and leather. Supple tannins and good acidity.
- Amarone di Valpolicella, Italy** 185

Complex, layered, savoury nose that kept on evolving in the glass. Full-bodied, richly flavoured with bright fruit flavours still showing strongly across the palate. Refreshing with well-integrated fine tannins. Long with a lovely lifted floral note on the finish.

Chiantari Nero D'Avola, Italy

50

This stunning Sicilian red produced by Vigneti Zabu is intense ruby red colour with violet notes. It has soft tannins and fresh red fruits predominate. It is full and persistent even in the flavouring.
