Shaw & Smith Sauv Blanc, SA

60

The current offering is bright and aromatic with notes of grapefruit, nashi pear and nettles. On the palate there is intense flavour with fresh, limey fruit, mouth watering acidity and remarkable purity.

Craggy Range Sauv Blanc, NZ

60

This is a wine with quite brilliant structure consisting of a fine line of acid and great minerality. Flavour notes of herbs, wet slate and gooseberry to give some varietal lift.

Babich Sauv Blanc, NZ

44

The bouquet is an inviting mix of tropical, passionfruit aromas. Palate entry is luscious and lively, bursting with passionfruit. This is a fantastic example of Black Label Sauvignon that is equally enjoyable on its own and with food.

Satyr Valiant Sauv Blanc, NZ

38

Ripe Hawke's Bay Sauvignon Blanc with typical stonefruit, tropical and gooseberry aromas. The palate has vibrant fruit and a soft finish with plenty of residual flavour. Serve lightly chilled with seafood and white meats.

Mike Press, Sauv Blanc SA

The awesome power and intensity of this wine will catch many by surprise; the bouquet is correct and varietal, but by the time it reaches the mid-palate you can sense the express train loaded with citrus, green pea and sparks of tropical fruits blazing through the finish and cleansing aftertaste of mouth watering acidity.

Le Fou The Madman, Sauv Blanc France

40

The Madman sauvignon blanc has been made to express the typically bright aromatics and the zippy, juicy flavours of grapes picked at optimum ripeness which retain their vibrant freshness and appetising fruit.

Fraser Gallop Sauv & Semillon Margaret River, WA

40

Pungent passionfruit, honeydew melon and lemon grass, create a vibrant and lifted perfume. A crisp and refreshing palate of grapefruit, lemon rind with hints of passionfruit in the background. This wine has the hallmarks of flavour, length, elegance and texture with a sizzling citrus finish.

Levantine Hill Sauv & Semillon, VIC

45

Overall complexity is enhanced by barrel fermentation on varying levels of grape solids. The palate is silken and long, with a fine interwoven backbone of natural acidity providing the framework for persistent tangy stone fruit flavours and a supple textural finish.

Levantine Hill Katherine's Paddock Chardonnay, VIC 165

Expressing elegance, sophistication and textural complexity, its exceptional fruit has been carefully picked and sorted before being fermented and matured in fine French oak. A complex, medium bodied Chardonnay with notes of stone fruit and grilled nuts.

Cloudy Bay Chardonnay, NZ 110

The cooler growing season played nicely into the hands of our desired refined and focused chardonnay style. The nose is bright with aromas of stone fruit, white chocolate and a touch of smoke. Lemon balm and green plums combine with flint and char on a fleshy palate and lingering finish.

Sileni, NZ 75

The Sileni Chardonnay has melon and stone fruit flavours with a hint of almond. Toasty and slightly nutty with nice depth of fruit, this wine is rich, mealy and lively, with nice intensity.

Terra Felix Chardonnay, Central VIC 34

This is a very elegant subtle cool-climate Chardonnay. Lemon and white peach aromas are supported by a whisper of oak on the nose and the palate is long and fine with lovely mouth feel and texture.

Levantine Hill Chardonnay, VIC
110

This Chardonnay is complex fruit characters of white nectarine, saffron, Pink Lady apple, chamomile flower, cashews and Leatherwood honey work in concert with a tactile interplay of chalk, silkiness and Beurre Bosc pear-like texture. Subtle acidity provides the backbone conveying the fruit and weight to a resounding finish.

Satyr Kereru Chardonnay, NZ 38

Flying High Chardonnay is light straw green in colour with flavours of nectarine and white peach. Full mouth feel with balanced acidity and long flavour length.

Inara Pinot Gris, VIC 48

This white wine is made with a lot of grace and weight. The appearance is golden straw. The aroma jumps out of the glass with pink musk, rose petal and honey suckle notes. The palate is light to medium bodied, long and weighty. Orange peel and pink musk notes heighten the senses and although there is some residual sweetness the wine, it finishes dry.

Gypsie Jack Pinot Gris, SA 44

This wine displays a lot of varietal Pinot Gris characters of pear, with some lifted floral aromatics compliment by some background spice and ginger with a hint of nutmeg. The palate is textured and balanced from lees contact but still holding good acidity to give a nice clean finish.

Mondaletto Pinot Grigio, Italy 35

Skins and stalks are immediately separated from juice and fermentation takes place in temperature-controlled stainless steel to preserve all typical varietal characteristics: Tasting Notes Colour: Pale straw. Bouquet: Fruit forward. Taste: Crisp with delicate flavours with hints of peach, melon, pear and lime.

Taglia Pinot Grigio, Friuli Italy 48

Straw yellow hues. Floral bouquets, acacia blossom, mineral notes, slateyness and meal, persimmons and pear. An intense, exquisitely balanced palate, filled with the fruits of the orchard, apples, nashi and pear. Wonderfully textural and pleasingly dry.

Babich Pinot Gris, NZ 44

Bold and expressive bouquet with suggestions of toast and vanilla spice, then peach and apple tones, some baked pear and quince moments, full and rich aromas overall. On the palate – dry, firm fruity and flavours of peach and apple then pear fruits, moderate to lengthy finish.

Moscato Sweet, Australia 30

This is quite a fizzy Moscato exhibiting a very pale straw colour and watery hue. The nose displays lifted ripe grapey aromas followed by some tropical fruit notes and a hint of sherbet. Sweet fruity palate entry and light body weight with grapey tropical fruit flavours and a touch of orange blossom.

Joshua Tree Watervale Riesling, SA 44

Very pale straw in the glass with a green hue, this is a vibrant Clare Riesling with aromas of lime and lemon. Its intense, spicy palate has lemonade-like citrusy intensity balanced by razor-like acidity. Very youthful - one for the cellar.

Farnese Pecorino Italy 50

The Farnese Pecorino Casale Vecchio white wine from the Abruzzo region of Italy is a wine worth seeking out. When this wine is poured it shows a yellow colour almost like an ageing semillon. It is a weighty wine on the palate although it has a bracing acidity with some oak nuances showing through. The finish is clean and long.

Petit Chablis Laroche, France 125

A generous and elegant wine. Light golden colour. Intense nose of flower, brioche and candied lemon aromas, evolving towards nuances of grilled hazelnut and spice as the wine matures. On the palate, the wine is straightforward, with a nice texture and finesse. It has a long aftertaste where floral and gingerbread notes dominate.

Patrick Puize Chablis Grand Cru Bougros, France 165

Pale, bright green-yellow. Aromas of lemon peel and white grapefruit are complemented by honeyed high tones on the nose. Gives an initially sweet impression but the wine's white peach fruit and silky texture are leavened by bright acidity. Concentrated, energetic and quite long, with a lightly tannic finish

Sancerre A.O.C., France 75

Intense and complex, this fresh, mineral wine with hints of grapefruit. The Sancerre Blanc vines are planted in communes within the Sancerre appellation. Grapes are harvested terroir by terroir when they reach their peak of ripeness. The juices from each individual terroir are then blended harmoniously to yield a unique and versatile wine.

83 Cotes de Provence Rose, France 50

Very pale pink in colour. The nose is aromatic and sweetly perfumed with aromas of strawberries and rose petals. The palate is elegant and effortless with light berry and candied fruit drop flavours lingering long on a soft, dry finish.

Red Wine

375ML St Hallett Blackwell Shiraz, Barossa 45

375ML Henschke Keyneton Euphonium Shiraz/Cabernet, Barossa 49

Forester Cabernet Sauv Margare River WA 48

Hugely aromatic impact with lifted black olive and tobacco leaf with hints of comforting Sweet Plum Pudding and chocolate. The palate is generous yet medium bodied, with finely grained.

Round Two Cabernet Sauv, SA 38

Cassis, black currant, licorice, mint and earthy tones. Ripe dark fruit characters flavours dominate the palate. Fine even tannin profile offers structural support and maintains length.

Amadio Cabernet Sauvignon, SA 45

This full bodied Cabernet Sauvignon reflects classic Cabernet. This intense wine opens into ripe mulberry, hints of mint and tobacco leave with overtones of cedar and spice. The mouth feel is comforting and cosy yet is built around firm, fine-grained tannins.

Two Left Feet Mollydooker, SA 70

Aromas of deep blackberry, plum and coffee with an underlying floral bouquet. These bold fruit flavours are closely followed by luscious chocolate, spice, licorice and creamy vanilla. Overall, a truly vibrant, ripe, and indulgent experience.

Levantine Hill Syrah VIC 85

The elegant medium-bodied palate abounds with spice and earthy nuances in a concentration of savouriness. The silky ripe tannins have been deftly integrated with the underlying oak providing carriage for the fruit weight and lingering flavours to a pronounced and persistent finish.

St Henri Shiraz, SA 175

The dark colour pre-empt a wine of dense, layered black fruit. The aromas of anise and cracked pepper are enveloped in classic blackberry. The structure imparted by oak and skin contact integrates well with the bright, but intense fruit.

Blue Eyed Boy Shiraz SA 90

Definitely no shrinking violet, this explosion of a wine has a dense black crimson colour and leaps from the glass with powerful aromatics of blueberries, ripe sweet fruit, licorice and undertones of chocolate biscuit.

Johns Blend Margaretes Shiraz SA 75

Colour - Very rich and intense red Nose - Extremely intense and rich chocolate and eucalypt mint showing. Complex French Oak. Pallet - Big, rich and full bodied with intense dark chocolate overtones. While full bodied, the palate is balanced with a soft tannin finish.

Gipsie Jack Shiraz, SA 44

Dense blackcurrant and blackberry fruit at the fore, along with some liquorice, chocolate and choc/berry notes. The palate has a core of briary, dark berry fruit with liquorice and chocolate.

- Buckshot Heathcote Shiraz, VIC** 60
Opaque black purple colour with dark purple hue. The nose provides an attractive bouquet of ripe blackberry, dark plum, a touch of liquorice and spicy oak. Medium to full bodied the palate possesses generous blackberry and plum flavours followed by some subtle liquorice, toasty oak and spice.
- Forester estate Shiraz, WA** 60
Stacks of ripe berry notes on the nose with a sprinkle of pepper and spices. It's a savoury expression of the variety typical of Margaret River. Controlled and medium bodied with an effortless finish. Dusty, earthy character on the palate with a slightly loamy influence. Still tightly wound and will benefit from further ageing.
- Round Two Merlot, SA** 36
Ripe plum and Mulberry, mocha and herbal spices. Rich, ripe and full, this fruit driven wine delivers dark fruit flavours and finishes with soft rounded tannins.
- The Coldstream Guard Rubeus Blend Levantine Hill, VIC** 45
Bright acidity runs through the length of the medium-bodied palate, which carries flavours of blueberry and fruit-spiced Christmas cake. Aniseed and cedar notes add nuance to its moorish, savoury flavour profile.
- Irvine The Estate Shiraz, SA** 38
Full bodied, yet elegant, this wine presents intense aromas of delightful blueberries, spices and aniseed. Dark berry fruits arrive with concentrated notes of cherry and dark chocolate.
- Craggy Range Pinot Noir, NZ** 110
Bright red cherry colour with a crimson hue. Seductive aromas of dark cherry, dried rose petals, thyme and damp earth. Beautifully varietal, elegant and long on the palate
- Bertaine Et Fils Pinot Noir, France** 45
Bright red cherry colour with a crimson hue. Seductive aromas of dark cherry, dried rose petals, thyme and damp earth. Beautifully varietal, elegant and long on the palate The nose displays raspberry and cherry aromas with a hint of fresh herbs.
- Levantine Hill Pinot Noir, VIC** 125
Aged as individual components for nine months prior to selection and blending pre-bottling. Fined with egg whites and minimally filtered. A bright crimson hue, this deeply complex and refined aromatic profile expresses intense characters of strawberry, black cherry and plum. Allspice, leather and earthy notes abound.
- The Coldstream Guard Pinot noir, VIC** 60
This pinot noir has dark cherry flavours, floral and dark fruit aromas, which follow through to the palate where the dark berry-fruit and cherry notes are supported by soft tannins.
- Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir, NZ** 90

An enticing wine that will awaken your senses from the very first encounter. Leather, boysenberry and sweet spices combine. The supple palate with its transparent flavours of red fruit and earthy textures leads to a finish that is both balanced and intriguing.

Mike Press Pinot Noir, SA 45

Floral and dark fruit aroma with dark cherry flavours, rich mouth feel and savoury toastiness. This has vital cut and thrust to its array of snow pea, gooseberry and guava flavours, the package neatly tied by no-nonsense acidity.

Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Italy 60

Bright ruby-red in colour, with delicious aromas of black cherries, strawberries, and herbs, Stella Montepulciano d'Abruzzo is dry, mellow, and concentrated. It is best enjoyed young, in order to fully appreciate its fruity varietal character.

Chianti, Italy 45

Chianti displays an intense ruby red colour. The perfume is fruity with scents of cherry. A medium body with a dry but harmonious taste is complimented by fruity notes of cherry and cinnamon. A great partner for pasta and tomato-based dishes as well as grilled meat, roasts and cheese.

Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy 70

Ruby-red. Bouquet: Intense with notes of cherries, plums, and violets. Taste: Rich flavours of cherry and leather. Supple tannins and good acidity. Food Pairing Perfect accompaniment to a wide variety of foods, including red-sauced pastas, grilled meats and roasts.

Chateauneuf-du-PAPE 2012, France 145

Diverse array of styles, characteristics of fresh red and black cherries, strawberry, kirsch, black pepper, black raspberry, spice, earth and garrigue, which is the fresh herbs typical of the region. The textures can be lush, lusty and luscious.

Vigne Vecchie Primitivo Di Manduria, Italy 145

Intense ruby red colour, wide and complex to the nose, fruity, with prunes, cherry jam aroma, with notes of tobacco, slightly spicy. Full-bodied wine, soft and rich in fine tannins, with notes of cocoa, coffee and vanilla in the end.

Amarone di Valpolicella, Italy 165

Complex, layered, savoury nose that kept on evolving in the glass. Full-bodied, richly flavoured with bright fruit flavours still showing strongly across the palate. Refreshing with well-integrated fine tannins. Long with a lovely lifted floral note on the finish.

Barolo, Piedmont, Italy 225

Rose petal, cherry and raspberry sauce, cinnamon, white pepper, with age, liquorice, leather, and chocolate. Pale and floral as it looks and smells, it is a punch on the tongue with its astringent tannin and high acidity.
